

# Important information about your BRP and changes to the UK immigration system



The UK border and immigration system is becoming digital. This means that physical documents like BRPs and vignette visa stickers are being replaced by eVisas.

## ● What this means for you:

### You have become a British citizen since you were last issued with a BRP

You will have right of abode in the UK. To prove your right to be in the UK, you can use your **British passport** or a **certificate of entitlement**.

- If you have a British passport, you do not need to do anything.
- If you have a certificate of entitlement, you may need to take action in the future. Further details will be provided at a later date.

### You are not a British or Irish citizen

You need to take action before your BRP expires on 31 December 2024.

## ● eVisa process

An eVisa is an electronic record of your immigration status. eVisas remove the need for physical documents, including BRPs. Updating your physical document to an eVisa does not affect your immigration status or the conditions of your permission to enter or stay in the UK.

You will need to create a UKVI account at <https://www.gov.uk/get-access-evisa>. This will require:

- Your date of birth
- Your BRP number
- Your passport (if you do not have a BRP)
- Access to an email address and phone number
- Access to a smartphone

## Continue on the app

### 1. Download the app

On your phone, search for and download the 'UK Immigration: ID Check' app in the Google Play or App Store.

### 2. Connect the app to your account

Open the app and select how you want to connect.

## Benefits of an eVisa

- Security – they cannot be lost, stolen or tampered with
- Access – access anywhere, in real time
- Easy to update – it's much easier to let the Home Office know of any changes, like a new passport issued by your home country, or email, telephone number and postal address changes.

## Travelling overseas during 2024

While eVisas are rolling out, you should continue to carry your in-date BRP until it expires. From 2024 onwards, if the passport or national identity document you are travelling with is linked to your UKVI account, airlines and other carriers will be able to digitally check that you have permission to come to the UK.

Be sure **to update your UKVI account with any passport you wish to use for travel** to avoid unnecessary delays when travelling internationally.
