Important information about your evisa to the UK immigration system The UK border and immigration system is becoming digital. This means that physical

documents like BRPs and vignette visa stickers are being replaced by eVisas.

eVisa process

An eVisa is an electronic record of your immigration status. eVisas remove the need for physical documents, including BRPs. Updating your physical document to an eVisa does not affect your immigration status or the conditions of your permission to enter or stay in the UK.

You will need to create a UKVI account at https://www.gov.uk/get-access-evisa.



This will require:

- Your Passport
- · Your date of birth
- · Access to an email address and phone number
- Access to a smartphone

Access your eVisa

You must first create a UKVI account.

To create an account, you'll need a phone number and email address that you can use each time you sign in.

You'll also need one of the following, if you have them:

- a valid passport and your visa application number this is a global web form (GWF) number or unique application number (UAN)
- a valid passport and your BRP number
- your expired BRP card you can use it for 18 months after the expiry date printed on the card

After you create your account you'll be asked to confirm your identity and link your account to your eVisa.

You'll need access to a smartphone so you can install an app to confirm your identity. You'll be able to confirm your identity another way if you either:

- do not have a valid passport or an expired BRP card
- cannot access a smartphone or use the app



Create a UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) account

You need to create a UKVI account to:

- · view your immigration status (eVisa) online
- · access someone's account so you can help them get an eVisa
- · act on behalf of someone who cannot manage their account. For example, a young child or vulnerable person
- · confirm your identity, update your details or get proof of your immigration status

What you need

You will need to provide some information about yourself, including your name, nationality, and date of birth.

If you have either a valid passport or a biometric residence permit (BRP), you will need to have this document with you. You can use an expired BRP if it expired less than 18 months ago. You can still create an account if you do not have one of these documents.

You will need access to your email address or phone number, as we will send codes to check it is really you. If you want to give someone access to your account, you will need their email and phone number.










You will then be directed to an Information page; again, read this carefully before choosing Create an account. If you are a parent acting on behalf of a young child, you will see some information below the Crete account button.










Depending on which you choose, you will see one of the following screens:

In either case you will be asked to confirm your Date of Birth. This is as per your passport and is Day, Month and Year




Login to your email account and check for an email from the Home Office. Remember it may go into spam, so check that folder before requesting a new security code. If the email does go into spam, make sure you mark it as NOT spam, to ensure you get all future emails.











You need to enter a Mobile Telephone Number, this can be a UK Mobile or International Mobile number. If the latter, you will need to add the international dialing code.

You will need to have the phone with you, as you will be sent a security code.

If parents are completing on behalf of a younger child, you can use your Mobile Number





1. Download the app

On your phone, search for and download the 'UK Immigration: ID Check' app in the Google Play or App Store.

2. Connect the app to your account

Open the app and select how you want to connect.

You can either enter the connection code or scan the QR code below.

Enter the code you are given and press connect.


Once you have finished, sign in to your account on a web browser to continue.

Sign in

You will be asked to scan your passport and take a photograph of yourself or the Visa holder. The instructions are quite clear, but you need to ensure you follow them correctly, especially when scanning your passport.
